Also, protect yourself from all infectious diseases by using these precautions:

- Keep 6 feet or more distance from others
- Wear a mask or face covering when unable to physically distance
- Wash hands often with soap and water – 20 seconds or longer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands or after touching surfaces
- Call before visiting a healthcare provider, to assure they are expecting you and the office is open and ready to help you.
