- 1. Meeting called to order by Kim Clemons at 1:03pm
- 2. Review and approval of January meeting minutes -- Motioned to approve minutes with minor punctuation error.
- 3 .Worksite Wellness Initiative (Kim Clemons) The Worksite Wellness Committee recently coordinated and sponsored (food and speaker) a meeting with the Chamber of Commerce (Westside) for a wellness event at "The Pig" restaurant. Kim reported that there was great turn-out (60 attendees) and excellent feedback.

These include HEPA (Healthy Eating and Physical Activity) standards, Youth Fit for Life program (including physical activity and educational components), and 5210 Initiative.
- 5. Dr. Seidel discussed Obesity prevention in Early Childhood Education centers as part of the "Let's Move Childcare" initiative
 - Discussed potential benefits for daycare centers of recognition as a designated "Lets Move Childcare" facility as well as potential barriers (time, paperwork, money, culture, parental buy-in, etc.)
 - Dr. Lauren Jones discussed school/state/federal partnership with Publix to promote "
 Fresh from Florida" campaign highlighting seasonal fruits/veggies—free resources and
 curriculum from USDA(?) to possibly aid daycare centers in educating parents on healthy
 lunch/snack alternatives
 - Dr. Seidel suggested drafting a letting on behalf of NCHIC to support healthy snack options in local ECE facilities to gain more support

- 6. Dr. Seidel previewed/ promoted upcoming Community Walk with National Surgeon General on April 7th (after school activity?) in Jacksonville
- 7. Community, Worksite Wellness and Behavioral Health Resource Guides –Kim asked local programs to make sure all their information is correct and up-to-date on the resource guides so clients have current information.
