SERVICES

Vital Statistics

Birth and death certificates can be obtained for a fee.

Healthy Start

Free and confidential services for all pregnant women, infants up to age 3, and their families. A personal care coordinator provides education and support on topics such as:

- Pregnancy and childbirth
- Breastfeeding
- Positive parenting
- Basic baby care and safety
- Referrals for community resources
- Screenings for baby's milestone

Epidemiology

- Disease control, prevention, and education
- Surveillance of reportable diseases

School Health

The goal of school health services is to ensure students are healthy, in school, and ready to learn. Services offered include:

- Dental, vision, hearing, scoliosis, and growth and development health screenings
- Nursing assessments
- Medication administration
- Immunizations
- Student health care development plans
- Home visits

Environmental Public Health

Inspection and evaluation of:

- Septic and well
- Piercings and tattoo
- Indoor air quality
- Public drinking water
- Public swimming pools
- Beaches
- Biomedical waste

Community Health

Collaborative efforts that support the prevention of disease and injury, improve health, and improve the quality of life for all.

Emergency Preparedness

- Coordinate and assist in the preparation, response, recovery, and mitigation of public health emergencies and disasters.
- Coordination of special needs shelter



HEALTH CLINICS

Services include:

- Primary Care
- Family planning
- STI prevention, education, testing, and treatment
- Immunizations
- Breast and cervical cancer screenings
- Tuberculosis testing and treatment
- HIV testing and referral, nPEP services
- Insulin and epilepsy medication programs

WIC CLINICS

Provides Women, Infant, and Children (WIC) program services, including:

- Nutrition counseling
- Breastfeeding information
- Breastfeeding peer counseling
- Referral to health care

DENTAL CLINICS

Dental services are for children, ages 1–20 that are uninsured, on Medicaid or KidCare, and adults that are on Medicaid HMO-based plans.

- Oral hygiene and cleanings
- Fluoride treatments
- Cancer screening
- Restorations
- Extractions
- Sealants
- Referrals
